Yard Waste

Shall mean vegetative matter resulting from normal yard and landscaping maintenance and shall include materials such as tree and shrub trimmings, grass clippings, palm fronds or small tree branches that shall not exceed four feet in length and four inches in diameter. Grass clippings shall be placed in a disposable bag. No bundle or bag shall exceed 50 pounds in weight and no more than six (6) collective bags or bundles per Residential Customer shall be collected at one time. Yard waste shall include Christmas Trees regardless of size.

Yard Trash shall be bundled or tied and placed by the curb for service.

Recycle

Will be collected from your recycling container on every Wednesday in all zones. You may place the container on the side yard or bring it to the curb; whichever you prefer. Be sure it is accessible, outside of your gate or fence. **All Cardboard must be flattened, bundled and placed out by the curb.*

Items Accepted as Recycling: Empty, clean and dry steel and aluminum cans, plastic bottles, glass bottles, paper cartons, cereal boxes, newspaper, magazines, cut or folded cardboard boxes and any variation of items listed.

Not Accepted as Recyclable: Light bulbs, china, glassware, food trays, plastic wrap, plastic bags, Styrofoam, batteries, paint or any hazardous items.

Regular Garbage

Will be collected twice a week from the garbage container. Place the container on the side yard or bring it to the curb; whichever you prefer. Be sure it is accessible, outside of your gate or fence. If plastic bags are used, they should be securely closed and tied. Garbage should not be heavier than the bags can effectively contain.

Allowed for Garbage:
1 cart & 2 bags



Allowed for Recycle:
1 cart; keep items in cart lose (not in plastic bags)
